


Deer Lakes Park Blazed Trails



Note: An equestrian group has marked trails for their rides with green spray painted circles. Their routes use many trails spread throughout the park. These blazes are not shown on the map.

The green hiking loop (in the northern half of the park) is blazed with green rectangles. If you see a green circle on a trail, it is NOT marking the green hiking loop. The trails are multi-use and may be used for hiking, biking, and horseback riding.



- Trail Legend**
- Red Loop - 1.75 Miles
 - Blue Loop - 2 Miles
 - Green Loop - 1.25 Mile
 - Purple Loop - 1 Mile
 - Orange Loop - 1.5 Miles
 - Yellow Loop - 1.25 Miles
 - White Trail - 3.75 Miles
 - Other Trails

Blaze Symbols for Deer Lakes Trail Map

Blue Loop: ■ Blue Loop Access: ●

Blazed trails are marked with solid rectangular blazes and are represented by a solid colored line on the map. Access trails and connector trails have a dotted blaze and are represented by a solid line overlaid by dashes.

To clarify the blazes, a blaze symbol points to its corresponding blazed trail.
