How to View Club-Member-Only Events & Information

There are two types of events posted to the <u>MIRA Astronomy Club website</u> hosted by NASA's Night Sky Network:


- Public Events: these events are listed on the right side of the club website home page and are visible to all website visitors. Examples of these events are the public "star parties" held at Garland Ranch Regional Park and WeatherTech Raceway Laguna Seca. These events appear and are searchable in the Night Sky Network's publicly available events calendar. These event postings may contain information visible only to registered club members, and only when logged into the Night Sky Network. Such information may include participant instructions, gate codes, astronomer parking maps, etc.
- Club-Member-Only Events: these events are NOT listed on the right side of the club website home page and are NOT visible to all website visitors. Examples of these events are quarterly club meetings, social coffee gatherings and members-only "star parties". Members's families and friends are always welcome at these events. To view these events, one must be a registered member of the MIRA Astronomy Club and one must log into the Night Sky Network website. These events are hidden from the public to ensure our members' (and their families' and friends') safety and privacy.

To view club-member-only events and member-only instructions at the club website:


Step #1: point your web browser to https://mira.org/club. When not logged into the club website, the list of events displayed under the heading "UPCOMING EVENTS" and behind the menu option "Events" are only the club's *public* events. You must log into the club website to view club-member-only events and information about public events intended to be seen only by club members.



Step #2: Click on the "LOGIN" button. If you have forgotten your login credentials, click on the link "Forgot your username or password?". If you still cannot log in, send a request to mac@mira.org.



Step #3: Click on "Upcoming Events". The next webpage will list all confirmed upcoming club events, both *public* events and *club-member-only* events. You may also click on the menu item "Events", but that brings you to a calendar webpage that shows only events for a single month.



Here is an example list of upcoming events, when viewed by a logged-in club member after clicking on the "UPCOMING EVENTS" link shown in the screenshot on the previous page. Click on the title of any of the events listed to view details about the event, including club-member-only information included in public event postings.
