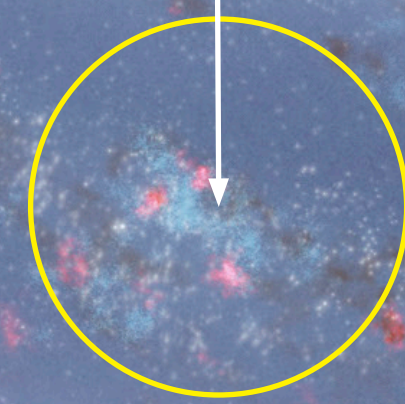


You Are Here
